Hurricane and Storm Damaged Asphalt Shingles:

Atlas Roofing Corporation shingles contain strips of asphalt sealant that after installation requires direct warm sunlight for several days in order to seal properly. Extreme weather wind events, such as tornados, hurricanes or Nor'easters, may cause the sealant bond between the shingles to break. Should this situation occur, it is unlikely that the shingles will reseal properly, which may lead to blow-offs in the future. As a result, the shingles exposed to these types of weather events the Limited Wind Warranty portion of the Limited Shingle Warranty may be voided. In the event that the sealant is broken due to high winds the shingles will not re-seal, which will void the wind warranty of the shingle. Atlas Roofing Corporation recommends that owners of shingles, which have been exposed to extreme weather wind events, have their shingles inspected by a roofing professional.

Homeowners who experience extreme weather events, such as the events described above but not limited to just those events, which have damaged their roofing shingles and other possible structural damage, should consider contacting their insurance carrier for coverage under their homeowner's policy.

Atlas Asphalt Limited Shingle Warranty provides coverage against blow-off damage due to wind gusts, up to the maximum wind velocity per the Wind Warranty MPH specified in the written Limited Warranty document. The Warranty does not cover wind due to Hurricanes, Tornados or other such storms with sustained winds. For complete details of coverage, please see the Atlas published Limited Shingle Warranty for the wind limit performance for the specifically branded Atlas shingles.

Atlas's Limited Warranty on roofing shingles is valid within the terms and conditions stated in the written warranty document. The Atlas shingle Limited Warranty covers manufacturing defects. Please refer to the printed Atlas Limited Warranty for full warranty coverage and provisions against manufacturing defects.
